Dear Parent or Legal Guardian:

A child in our program has: ROSEOLA

Information about this disease:

The disease is spread by: Person to person contact through saliva.

The Symptoms are: High fever for 3-5 days with runny nose, irritability, eyelid swelling and tiredness. When the fever breaks, a pink patchy rash appears over the neck, chest and body

The disease can be prevented by: Good hand washing. Avoid sharing food and utensils.

When should children with this illness be excluded? Children with a rash and fever are excluded until the child has been fever free for 24 hours without the use of Tylenol or Motrin.

What the program is doing to reduce the spread: Teach children good hand washing. Wash mouthed toys.

What you can do at home to reduce the spread: Good hand washing

If your child has any symptoms of this disease, call your health care provider to find out what to do and be sure to tell them about this notice. If you do not have a regular health care provider to care for your child, ask staff here for a referral. If you have any questions please contact:
