

Parental Agreement between the Parents & Shasta Head Start for Storing and Releasing Breast Milk to Parents

I have read the “Parent Sheet for Breastfeeding Mothers—Storing & Transporting Human Milk” and follow these procedures for storing and transporting my breast milk.

Head Start will do the following to ensure that the breast milk you bring in your sealed containers is stored safely:

1. Refrigerate your labeled breast milk immediately when received
2. Follow Shasta Head Start procedures (refer to the EHS Section in the Health Manual) regarding “Preparation and Handling of; Bottle Feeding”; “Feeding Human Milk”; “Warming Bottles and Infant Foods”; and “Cleaning and Sanitizing Equipment Used for Bottle-feeding”
3. Discard breast milk from containers that have been opened
4. Breast milk, stored in your unopened containers, that is not used or picked up by the end of the day, will be labeled and frozen
