

Guidelines for Siblings and Non-Enrolled Children in the Center

Shasta Head Start centers are licensed to serve children of the ages designated on the center's license. For this reason, and for the safety of all children, we have established the following guidelines:

- When parents bring babies or toddlers into classrooms they are not enrolled in, we ask that they hold them or keep them in arm's reach for their own safety. The environment may not be appropriate for infants and toddlers and can be dangerous.
- When parents bring older children into classrooms they are not enrolled in, we ask that the children stay in the designated waiting area. If one is not available, please keep them within arm's reach. This is for the safety of all children.
- Siblings and non-enrolled children should only be present in an SHS classroom while the enrolled child is being signed in or signed out.
- Parents with non-enrolled children, attending a parent meeting outside of regular class hours, may be provided childcare on-site.
- Parents who are volunteering to help in the classroom need to leave siblings at home so they can focus on their child and help the teacher.
