### Follow-up and Reflection (Changes made, date completed, time extended)

Winter: 12 children are at Building Middle which is 80% of the class. Only 1 child remained in the Building Earlier. Of the previous DRDP rating there was 14 children 82% in Building Earlier.

Spring: 5 children are Building Middle 33%. 8 children are Building Later 53% and one child is Integrating Earlier 7% There is still on child at Building Earlier. From the data the

children did make progress in ATL\_REG 5. The children used sand timers and more problem-solving solutions than the beginning of the year. In the beginning of the year we started with 0 children in the building later to 8.
